## GVTC Launches Triad's Calix B6 Interface to Auto Provision DSL From Billing to DSLAM

***GVTC, the largest telephone co-op in Texas, uses Triad's tools to audit, integrate and convert 12,000+ DSL lines to interface with Calix B6 ESANs, achieving full flow-through provisioning from billing to DSLAM port.***

"Triad's robust auditing tools allowed us to reconcile the way our DSL network was provisioned in terms of end user services with the service information in our billing system. It was very enlightening." In addition, Triad's host API gave GVTC the ability to import large amounts of customer-specific DSL circuit data, effectively managing the conversion process in-house.

"Being able to automatically push accurate data from the billing system to Triad all the way to the DSLAM port is the beauty of flow-through provisioning," said O'Neal.
